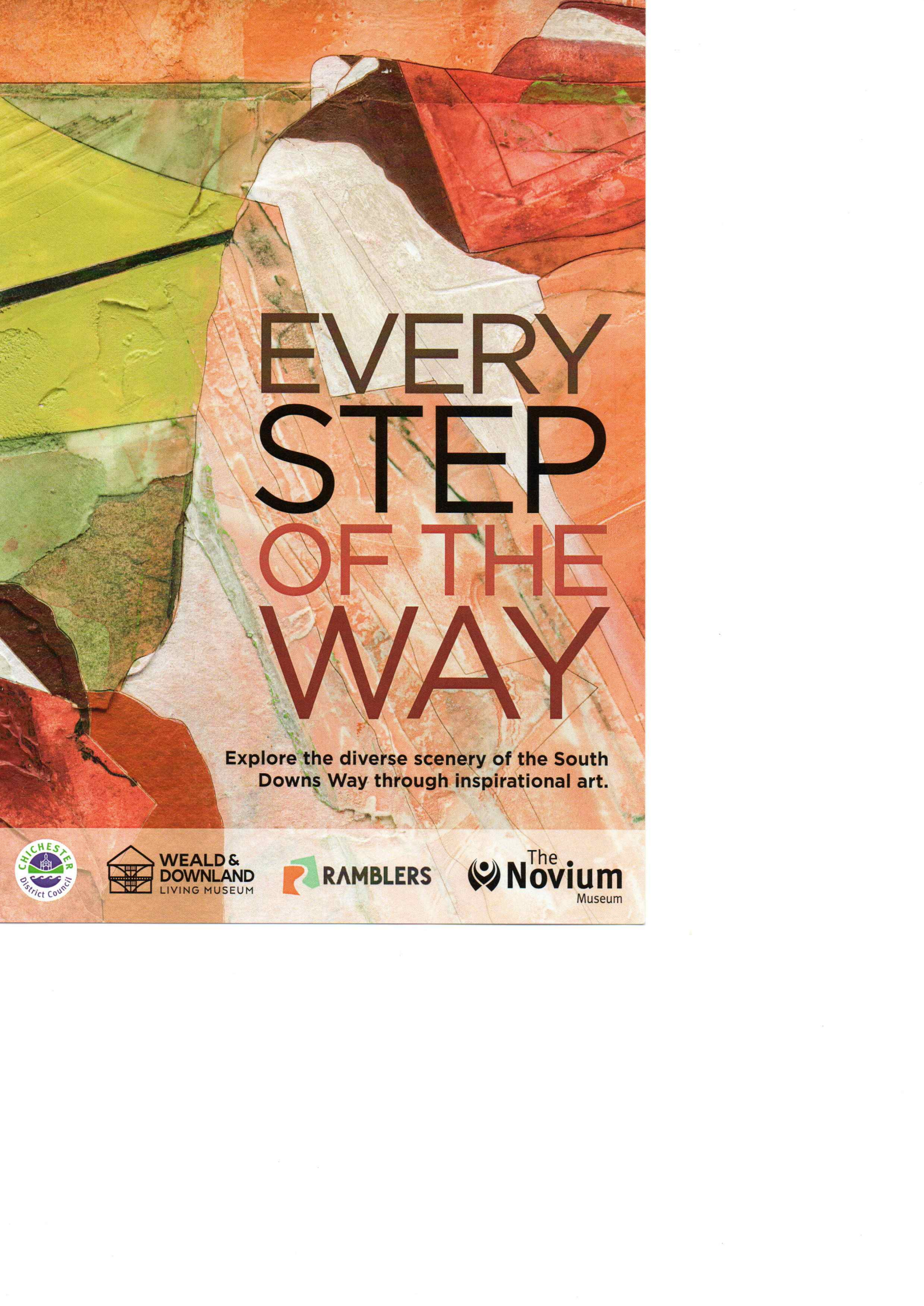

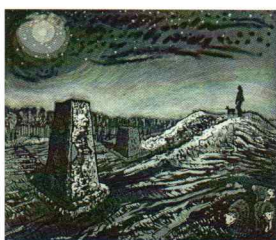

***Every Step of The Way* is an exhibition across two venues: The Novium Museum and Weald & Downland Living Museum.**

From Eastbourne to Alfriston, Washington to Amberley, Exton to Winchester, *Every Step of the Way* illustrates walking the 100-mile South Downs Way, as 33 artists (across the two venues) articulate their personal experience of the trail through their art. The exhibitions are structured around the 11 sections of the national trail, with each artist responding to The Way through the lens of their creative practices.
